

**Enrollment application question Section VII (check block have or have not been convicted of Major Misdeam. or Felony)**

Seccen is receiving applicants that have checked have been convicted of Maj. Misdem or Felony & no further explanation/details and/or court documents are being provided with application. There are also no waiver memos from the Diraux for these applicants.

If the applicant is a convicted Felon & Diraux does not grant waiver then the Director can reject application.

Providing all ppwk at beginning of process makes for a timely adjudication thus enabling the applicant to be vetted or not.

(FELONY) In accordance with the Aux Manual - Chapter 3 - Section A (Eligibility) A.4. - Criminal Convictions - states Auxiliary membership should be denied if the applicant has a felony conviction. The Director may recommend to the CG Seccen waiving the denial (under reasonable circumstances) as outlined in the CG Recruiting Manual (COMDTINST M11000.2). Section A.4.C.1 - Applicants w/a Felony conviction - states provide all ppwk (enrollment pkg, court docs regarding Felony, brief letter explaining situation (mitigations)).

(MAJ MISDEM) In accordance with the Aux Manual - Chapter 3 - Section A (Eligibility) A.4.a. - Major Misdemeanor - states Auxiliary membership should be denied if the applicant has a major misdemeanor conviction related to drug possession or use, sexual deviation, aggravated assault, and those other major misdemeanor crimes, as set forth in the CG Recruiting Manual. Notwithstanding any of the above, the Director may recommend to the CG Seccen waiving a denial, as provided in those provisions contained in the CG Recruiting Manual.

Seccens Memos (UNFAV & FINAL UNFAV) utilizes the CG Aux Manual & CG Recruiting Manual as references. In particular the Recruiting Manual (Chapter 2-Table 2-11, Appendix 1 & 2) is referenced in the body of the memos.
