LIVINGSTON COUNTY, KY - The search for a man who disappeared in a local river Tuesday will resume Wednesday. Starting around 9 a.m. the search and recovery effort will begin with crews using more equipment and volunteers.

Authorities say the jon boat two men were riding in Tuesday afternoon capsized along a stretch of the Ohio River in Livingston County. One man made it to shore safely, but the other man -who's name isn't being released- disappeared into the water.

Tuesday family and friends of the missing man gathered to support one another. Many of them were seen hugging and crying.

The boat the men were riding in was recovered and taken to the scene for a brief time.

Further information: Neither man was wearing a life jacket. Boat was found 12 miles downstream. Ohio River at this time is in flood stage

Man Drowns In Murray, Kentucky

Autopsy results show that 56-year-old Donald Seitz did in fact drown.

The Calloway County Coroner's Office says Seitz was at Boyd's Landing near Hamlin last night where it appears his boat got away from him while he was trying to hook it up to a trailer.

Seitz was pronounced dead at one o'clock this morning.

Further information: Local authorities determined that Seitz had attempted to swim after the boat. He was not wearing a life jacket
